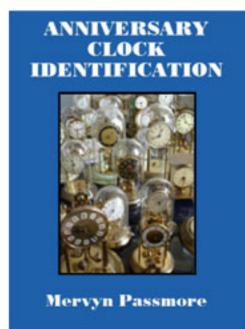

Backplate information:

Koma beneath a semicircular clock with hands at 10:12 Made in Germany Model:

Koma miniature late, internal ratchet

42mm x 77mm x 25mm






Movement ID code: KM-MLI

Internal ratchet, between the barrel and the front plate.

Notes:

This is the later model, with the stronger mainspring. The spring on the earlier design proved too weak. This model had a wider barrel, with two wheels re-arranged to accommodate the change. Not to be confused with the same size plate with the ratchet on the back plate.



13-20 Konrad-Mauch

Koma miniature late, internal ratchet 42 x 77 x 25mm

Notes

Lantern cased models may have screwed cases, so a rear hand setter was required. This is a shaft through the hole in the top right-hand corner of the plates, engaging with the motion work.

The internal ratchet made a space for the pendulum locking bracket on the back plate.


Later models were fitted with escapement guards.



Rapid Recognition Tips

Only this movement has plates of 42mm x 77mm and no ratchet on the back.

The distinctive Koma cut-out in most back plates.
